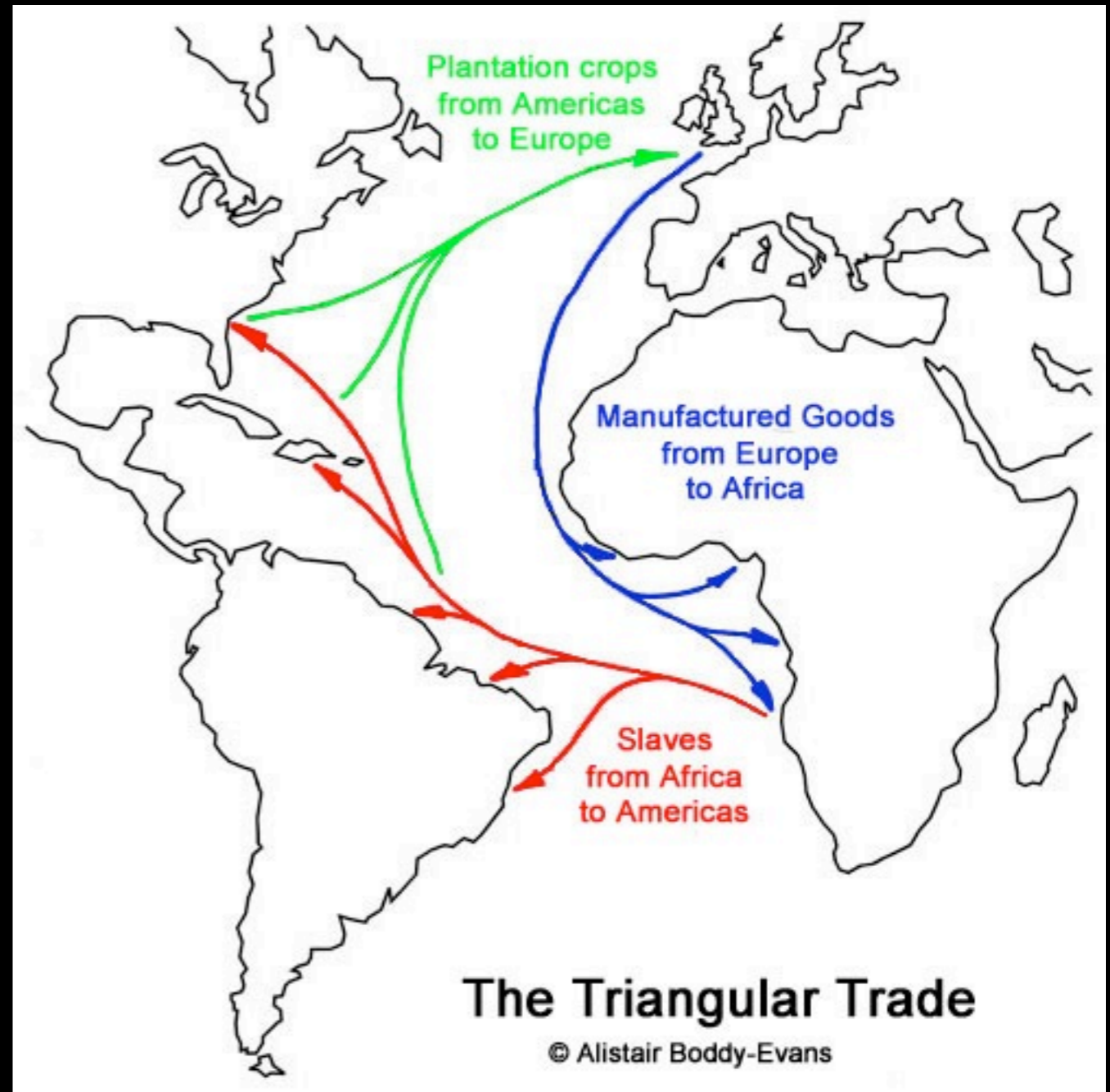

- Be prepared to share your answer.



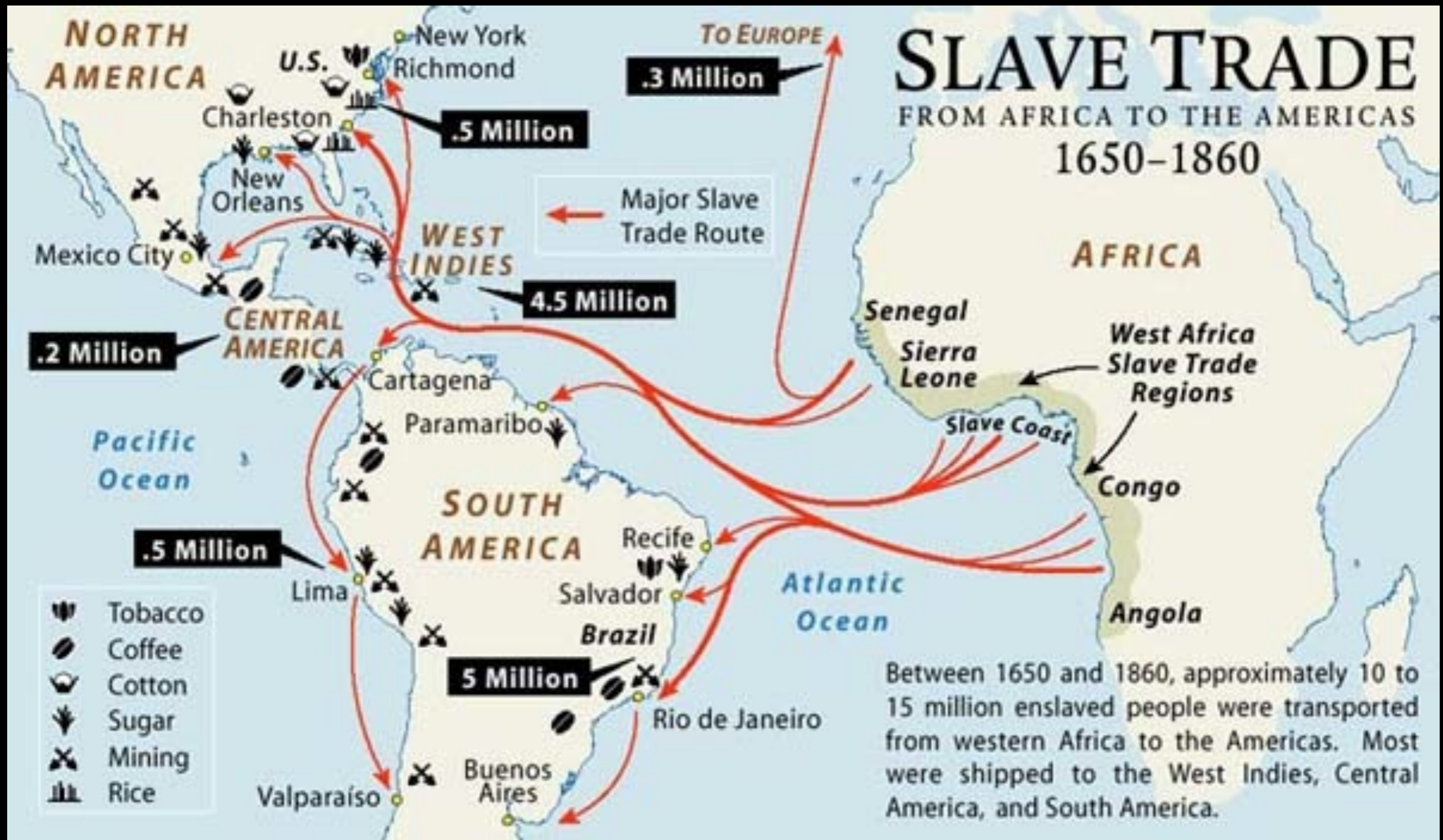
What was the Triangular Trade?
