

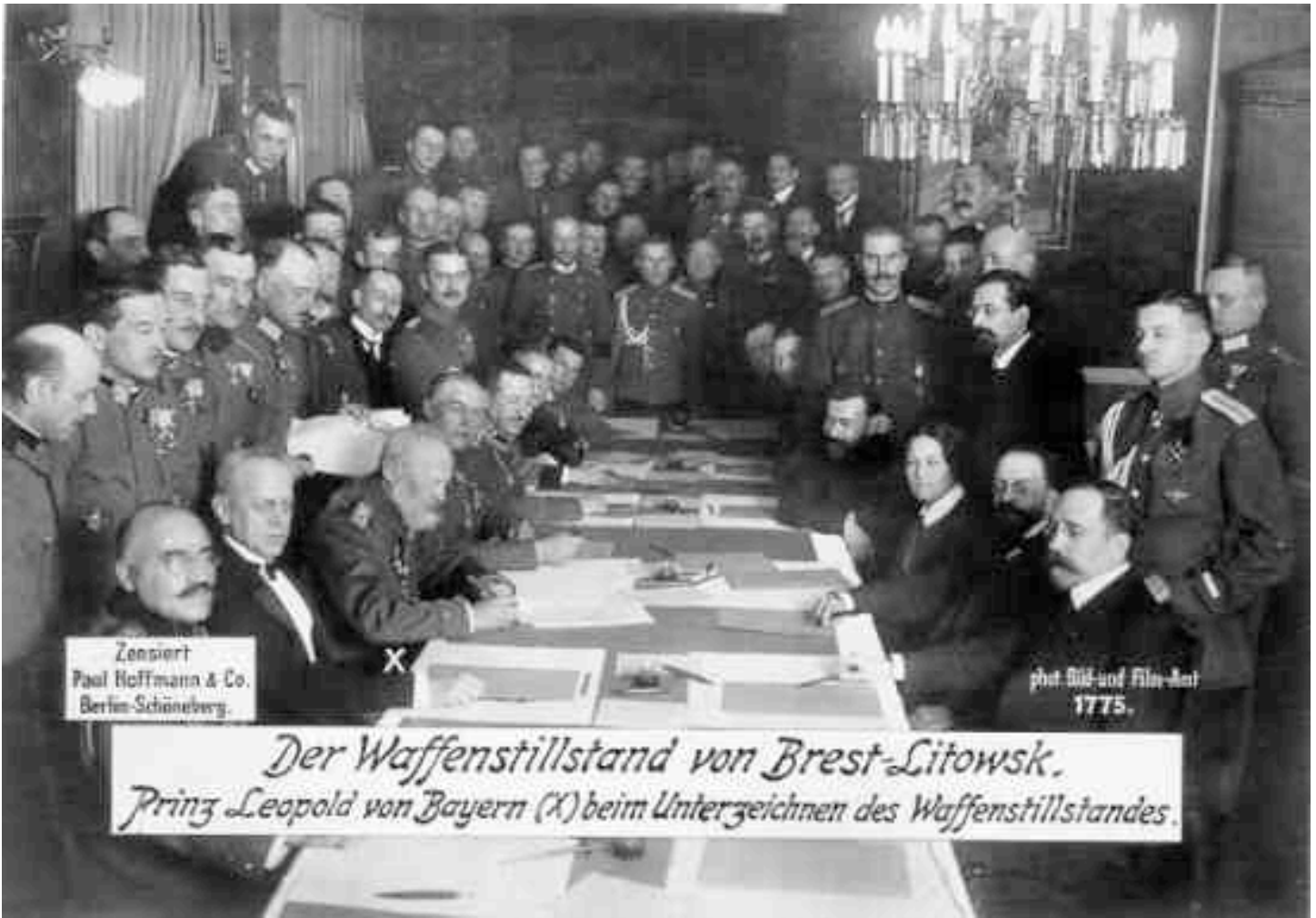
# Why Did the United States Enter WWI?

## The Russian Revolution
