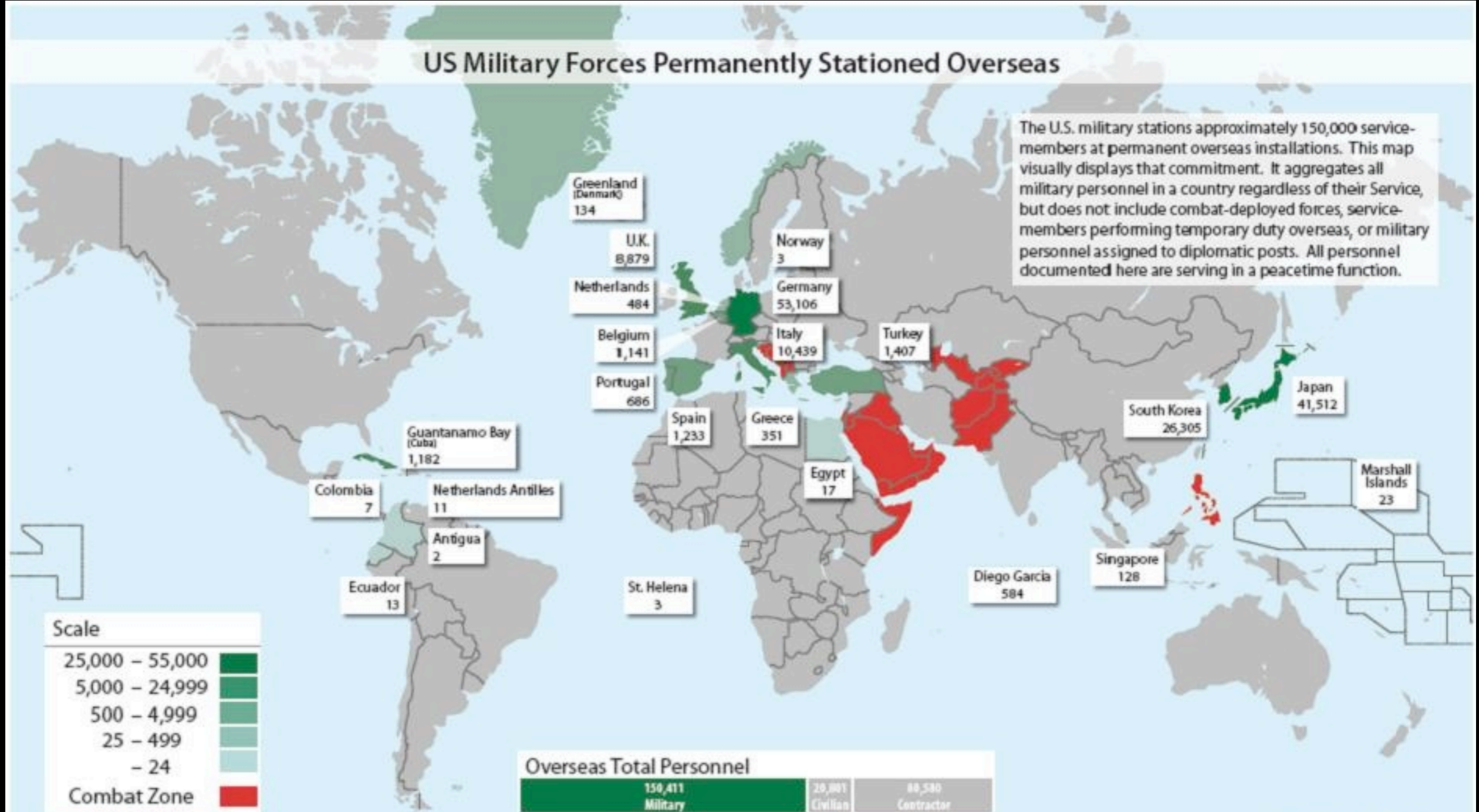

## US Military Forces Permanently Stationed Overseas

The U.S. military stations approximately 150,000 service-members at permanent overseas installations. This map visually displays that commitment. It aggregates all military personnel in a country regardless of their Service, but does not include combat-deployed forces, service-members performing temporary duty overseas, or military personnel assigned to diplomatic posts. All personnel documented here are serving in a peacetime function.

# WWI - Total War

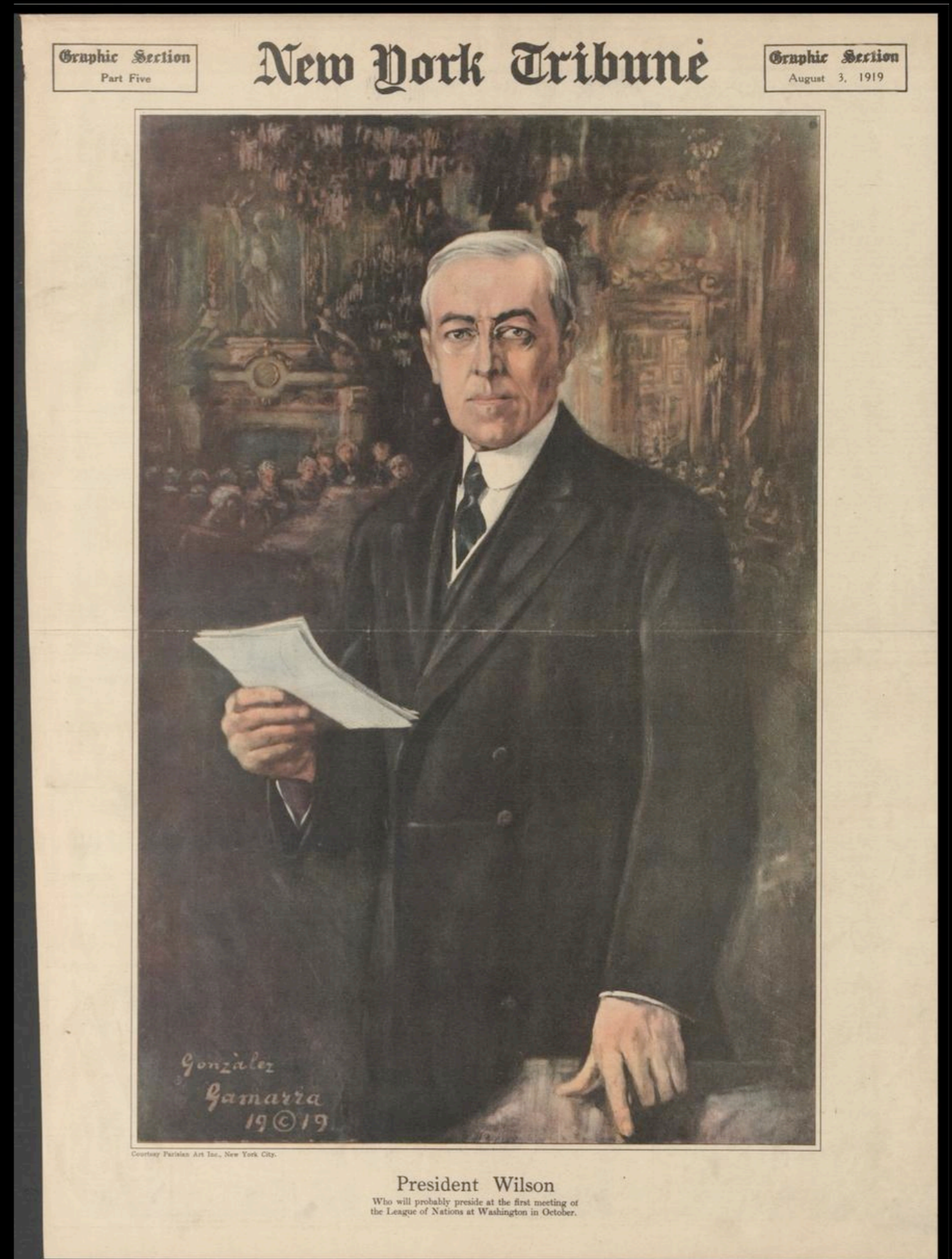
- **total war** - countries devote all of their resources to the war effort

- Why did the U.S. avoid getting involved in the war for so long?

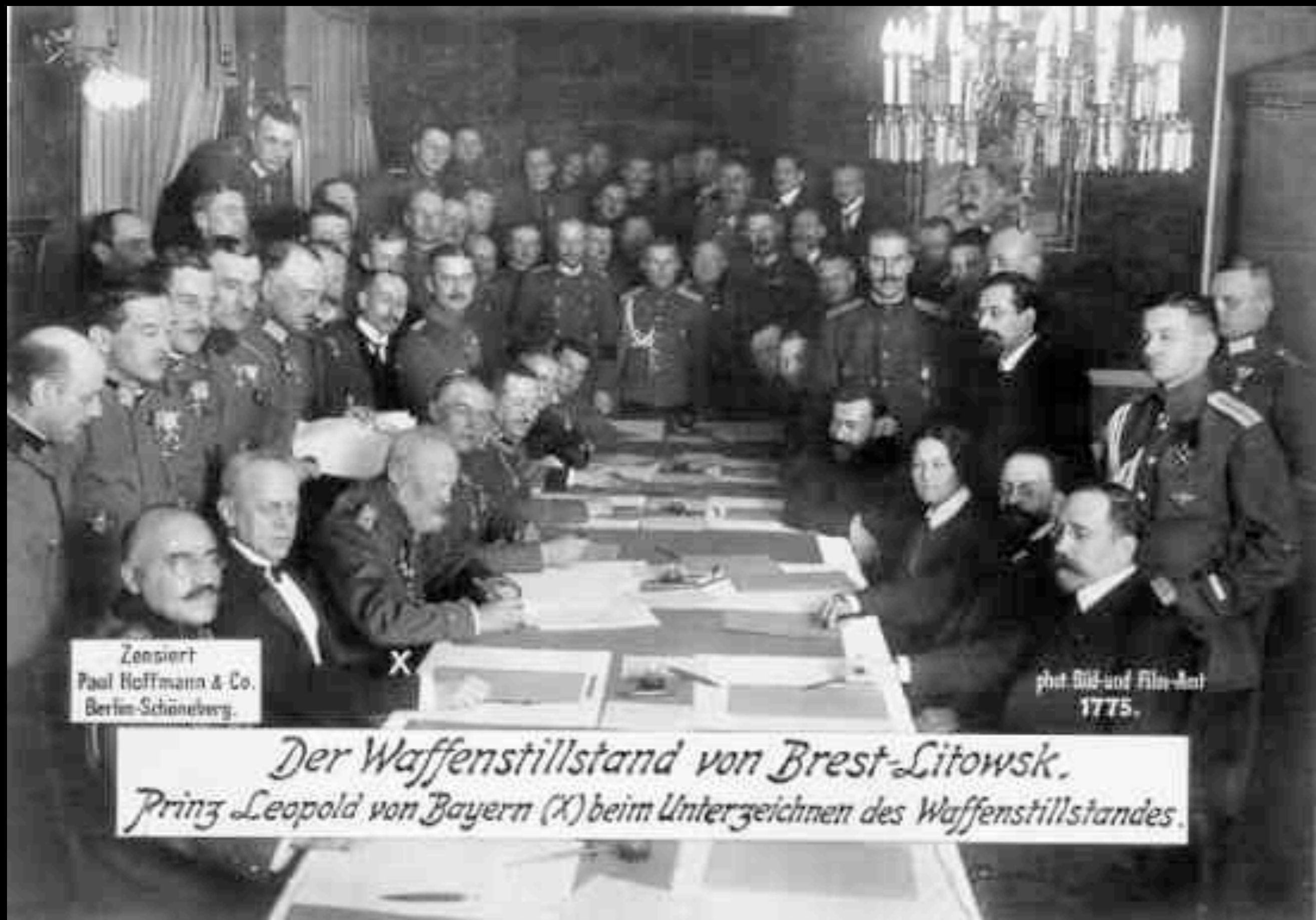
# US & WWI

- Woodrow Wilson “*architect of neutrality*”





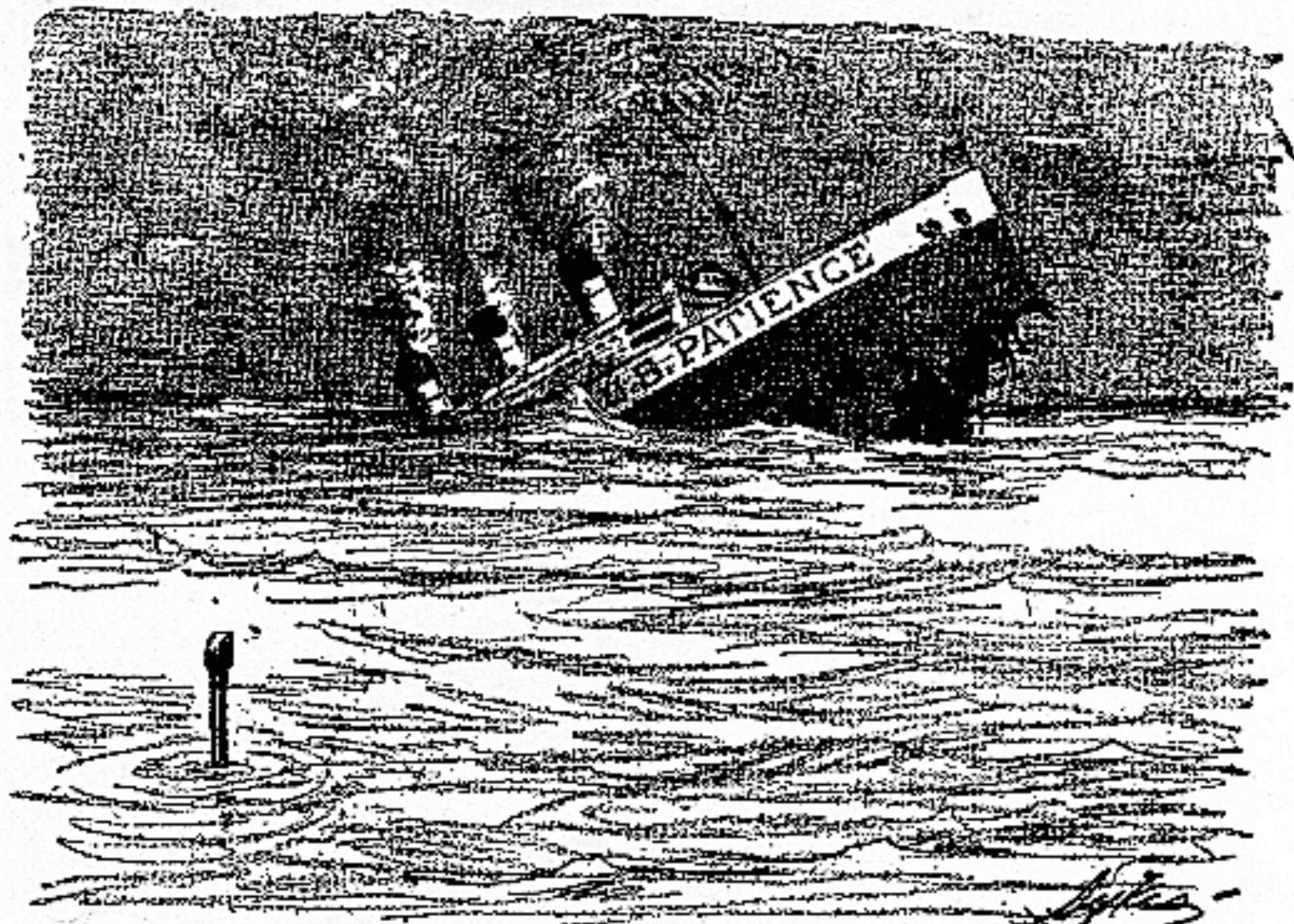
